NATIONAL MEAT INSPECTION SERVICE

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General Requirements for Licensing, Registration and Accreditation as Meat Importer

A. Requirements:

- 1. **Notarized Accomplished Application Form** with 2x2 coloured picture
- 2. **Bureau of Custom Account Manage Office (AMO) Certification** *formerly known as Interim Customs Accreditation Registration (iCARE)* (certified true copy)
- 3. For Single Proprietorship:
 - DTI Registration (certified true copy)
 - Certificate of Capitalization from a reputable Bank of at least Php5,000,000.00 (original copy)

For Corporation/Partnership/Cooperative:

- Certificate of Good Standing for the current year (original copy)
- Latest General Information Sheet and certified list of incumbent executive officers of good standing from the SEC or Cooperative Development Authority (certified true copy)

(The total paid-up capital must have a minimum amount of Php5,000,000.00)

- 4. **TIN Certificate of Registration** (certified true copy)
 - Pursuant to NMIS Memorandum Circular No. 02-2018-003
- 5. **Notarized Lease of Contract** or **Proof of Ownership of Cold Storage** or **Dry Warehouse Facility** (certified true copy)
- 6. **Accreditation Certificate of all Cold Storage Warehouses** public commercial and in-house CSWs (certified true copy)
- 7. **Notarized Affidavit of Undertaking** of conditions for accreditation (original copy)
- 8. Schedule of Fees
 - a. Accreditation Fee Php 4,000.00
 - b. Mailing Fee This shall be based on the current/prevailing market price
- 9. **Certificate of Attendance** to the Monthly Meat Importers Orientation on NMIS meat importation procedures and other relevant policies by the owner/manager/broker at the NMIS Office
- 10. For Renewal
 - Summary Report of Importation (Pursuant to NMIS Memorandum Circular No. 12-2017-022)

B. Additional Requirements:

- a. For Meat Processor MIP
 - Meat Processing Plant (MPP) Accreditation Certificate

(License to Operate (LTO) of Food and Drug Administration (FDA) as Food Manufacturer)

- HACCP Certificate of Products utilizing Indian buffalo meat

(LTO for Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points (HACCP) of FDA)

- b. For Meat Trader MIT
 - List and/or Target of Clients and address for the past year
- c. For Institutional User MII
 - Department of Tourism (DOT) Accreditation/Classification (certified true copy)
- d. For Duty Free Institutional User/Shop DFS & DFL-MIIU
 - Certificate of Registration and Tax Exemption from the concerned Duty Free Authority (certified true copy)
- e. For Duty Free Meat Importer Processor & Customs Bonded Warehouse DFL-MIP
 - License/Permit to Operate a CBW from BOC
 - FDA LTO as Food Manufacturer

Note:

- 1. A company's/Cooperative's authorized representative shall submit a Board Resolution of the Corporation/Cooperative Authorizing the Legal Representative together with a copy of two valid IDs with picture and signature.
- 2. A Broker shall submit a SPA, certified true copy of the License as Customs Broker, and copy of two valid IDs with picture and signature
- 3. All documents must be secured in a folder according to the checklist requirements.
